Eula Pearl Carter Scott, youngest pilot in the US on 9/12/29 when she took her first solo flight. Pearl is a Chickasaw Native American from Marlow, OK. Many history heroes played important roles in the Chisholm Trail Region. Inventors, pilots, entertainers, professional sport players, ballerinas, artists and more will be discovered during this session.

Pre-visit Discussion

- ◇ The Five American Indian Ballerinas were from different tribes and areas of Oklahoma, they all impacted the world of dance and held their heritage proud in their hearts.
- ◇ Will Rogers was a comedian, columnist, radio personality and cowboy. He had the ability to entertain people wherever he went.
- ◇ Mickey Mantle, American professional baseball player. His 565 foot home run in 1953 coined the phrase "Tape Measure Home Run."

Wiley Post was born in Texas, moved to Oklahoma when he was only 5. Post was an aviator and inventor. He was the first pilot to fly solo around the world. He developed the first pressure suit and discovered the jet stream.
