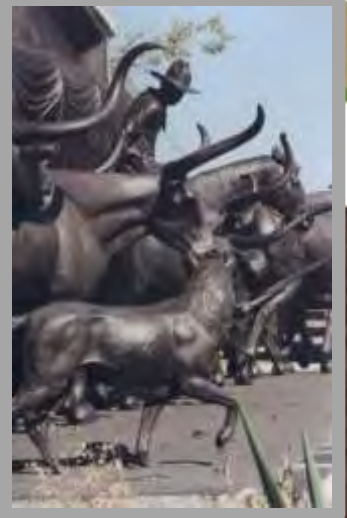




Your Chisholm Trail Heritage Center ROUND-UP

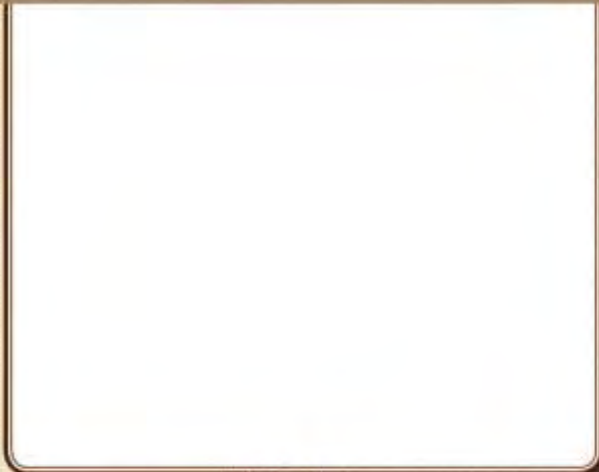


VISION STATEMENT:

SUMMER PROGRAMS A HUGE SUCCESS AT CTHC

Did the children in your life learn Art, Music, Science, Sociology, and History this summer? Did they participate in a bear dance? How many can tell you the importance of cattle ranchers to the settlement of our region?

Young people enjoyed our experience theater, Jesse and Tex in our Campfire Theater, and roping and riding in the interactive area. They also experienced a tracking skills activity while learning about the animals along the Chisholm Trail. An art project which replicated the cave drawings of Native Americans was another highlight of the summer session. All the participants enjoyed the bear dance and using musical instruments to reenact the movement and rhythm of the original Oklahomans. Participants, young and young-at-heart, were able to wear the bear skin and feel the buffalo hide. Everyone in attendance went home with a souvenir arrowhead, lots of information, and a smile on their face.

Garis Gallery of the American West

This Mark Martensen piece, 'Geronimo,' stands as sentinel to our wonderful art gallery. This 3/4 size bronze was done in 2005 just prior to the opening of the GGAW and is 1 of 15; it is 46 inches high with a 30" base.

Geronimo and the small group of insurgents that rode with him are the only Native American's that the U.S. Congress ever officially declared war on. They outran the U.S. Army for a while then finally turned themselves in. They were reunited with their families in FL, held there for a couple of years, taken to AL for a year then brought to OK Territory to be held prisoners at Ft. Sill.

Decedents of these people are now known as Ft. Sill Apaches.
